Information will be available for birding spots including Hale, Oscoda, Tawas City, and East Tawas, such as Tuttle Marsh, Iargo Springs, Lumberman’s Monument, and the Scenic River Road Byway.

A Bird sighting list will be on display near the lighthouse trailhead on Friday & Saturday and a shorebird identification station will be set up on the South shore of the point.
