Pine River Campground offers a variety of recreation opportunities such as hunting, picnicking, mushroom gathering and berry picking. Fishing for steelhead and trout is also popular in this area. This beautiful campground is located on the south branch of the Pine River and allows families to experience and enjoy nature. This area is also a prime location for viewing habitat for the endangered Kirtland's warbler songbird.

LOCATION

Pine River Campground is located in Alcona County, Michigan. The nearest community is Glennie, about 9 1/2 miles west.

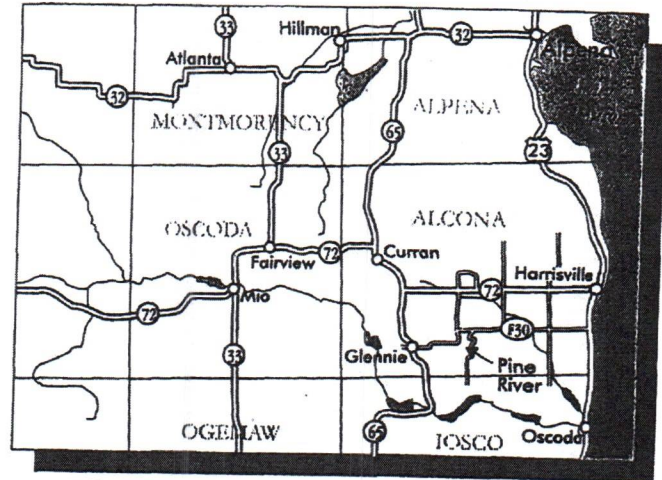
ACCESS

From the west, leave M-65 at Glennie and Follow F-30 east about 9 miles to Rearing Pond Trail (Forest Road 4121). Turn south and travel 2 miles to the entrance.

From the east, from Mikado, travel west on F-30 about 8 miles to Rearing Pond Trail (Forest Road 4121). Turn south and travel 2 miles to the entrance.
